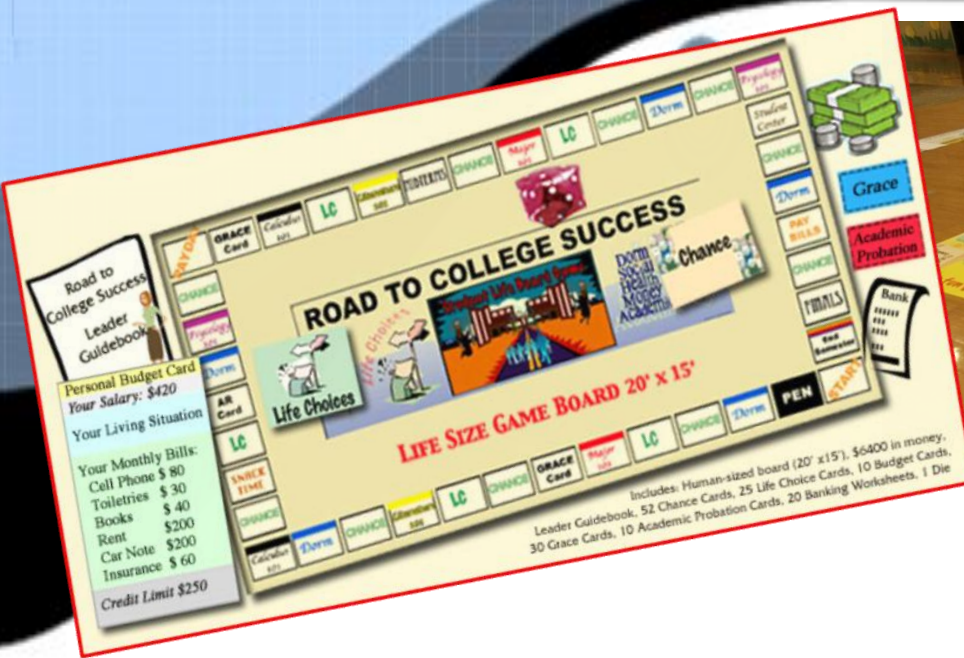

PART 1: Money Skills Games

Road To College Success (for older teens with a college focus)

Road To College Success (RTCS) is a human-sized board game used to prepare high school students and college freshmen for life in College. Players walk around the human-sized board registering for classes, managing money and discussing “risky” scenarios that could arise on a college campus.

Budget Mania (for pre-teens to adults)

Budget Mania (BM) is a game that all about math! It shows how algebra is integrated in everyday activities of shopping, balancing a checkbook, banking, budgeting, investing, etc.

PART 2: Taking The Fear Out of Banking, Borrowing and Balancing a Checkbook

This segment gives an overview of banking, gaining income, saving and the use of cash, credit, checks and debit cards. Our “Let’s Do A Deal, If the Answer Is Right” game keeps the energy high. Checkbook balancing goes wild using “Busy Banking”. Students learn simple ways to make money in this economy and a savings plan for college.

PART 3: Interactive Budgeting

This segment begins with a Mail Call where students receive an envelope filled with bills and their paycheck. Their goal is to create a budget using a simple 5 step process. Can they do it? Of course they can!

Earning Money, Saving & Giving – for PreTeens Part 1: Students learn how to develop a simple business/marketing plan around teen-based service jobs (lawn moving, dog walking, baby sitting, etc.) Then based on their earnings, develop their approach to save & give Part 2: Using stations around the room, teens will perform a job, get paid, pay bills, give money, shop and save money. Balloons are given to track the amount of money saved and prizes awarded to the top savers!
